**7th Grade:**

<b>Family &amp; Consumer Science:</b> 1 box of straight pins & container and one 12-quart plastic storage tub with lid (bring 2nd semester)
<b>Reading:</b> writing utensils, 1 three-prong folder
<b>Science:</b> 2" binder, ear buds, loose-leaf paper, calculator
<b>English:</b> a 1" binder, writing utensils, and a notebook (composition or spiral)
<b>Social Studies:</b> 1" binder just for social studies
<b>Math:</b> notebook, a 1" binder, scientific calculator
<b>Computer:</b> set of ear buds or headphones for listening to lessons
<b>JH Choir:</b> black folder, pencils
<b>JH General Music:</b> folder, pencils

**8th Grade:**

<b>Reading:</b> Writing utensils
<b>Science:</b> 2" binder, loose-leaf paper, ear buds, calculator
<b>English:</b> a 1" binder, writing utensils, and loose leaf paper
<b>Math:</b> notebook, a 1" binder, scientific calculator, graph paper
<b>History:</b> 1" binder just for history, loose-leaf paper
<b>Computer:</b> set of ear buds or headphones for listening to lessons
<b>Family &amp; Consumer Science:</b> 1 box of straight pins & container
<b>JH Choir:</b> black folder, pencils
<b>JH General Music:</b> folder, pencils
<b>Algebra:</b> scientific calculator other than your phone, 1" binder

**9th Grade -12th Grade**

<b>Accounting:</b> an external 10-key keypad **highly recommended
<b>Geometry:</b> scientific calculator other than your phone, 1" binder, compass, protractor
<b>Algebra I:</b> notebook, a 1" binder, scientific calculator, graph paper
<b>Algebra II and higher:</b> graphing calculator recommended (TI-83/TI 84), 1½ " binder and paper
<b>U.S. History:</b> notebook and folder
<b>AP US History:</b> 3-ring binder
<b>Clothing:</b> straight pins & container, 1-yard of cotton woven fabric with a printed side, old pair of jeans or scrap denim pieces. Students will select projects within categories on a contract and then will purchase the pattern, fabric, and supplies needed for at least 2 projects. These items will need to be purchased by the 4th week of the course.
<b>9-11 English:</b> 1 pack index cards and Post-it notes, notebook, blue or black pens
<b>Health:</b> notebook to use for a journal
<b>Foundations of Writing:</b> college ruled notebook, lined index cards, pocket folder, 1½-2" three-ring binder, loose-leaf paper
<b>Spanish I-IV:</b> Notebook, folder
<b>Conceptual Chemistry:</b> 1 ½ "binder just for chemistry, ear buds, 4 pk of white board markers, scientific calculator
<b>Biology:</b> 3-ring binder
<b>Foundations of Math:</b> scientific calculator other than your phone, 1"binder
<b>Chemistry II:</b> 1 ½ "binder just for chemistry, ear buds, 4 pk of white board markers, scientific calculator
<b>Comp I &amp; II:</b> 3-ring binder
<b>Pre-Employment Strategies:</b> binder and clear sheet protectors
<b>Foods 1-</b> ingredients for chosen pie final and a pie plate or tin-not needed until end of semester
<b>Foods 2-</b> ingredients to make 10 "At-Home" recipes they will be required to cook for their family (7 assigned categories & 3 choice recipes); If a family/student has issues with this assignment they will need to contact the teacher within the first 2 weeks of the course and arrange time before or after school to prepare recipes.
