Open House - ProSchool -6th Grade - August 20th

During this time, students and parents will be able to explore the classroom, unpack their child’s supplies and visit with their child’s new teacher.

Preschool - Home visits

Preschool teachers will be conducting home visits. So, Mrs. Askeland or Mrs. Streicher will be contacting families to schedule a time that meets your family’s needs to get acquainted with each other. If you have any questions do not hesitate to contact the office. We are looking forward to getting to know all of you!

Cell Phone and Attendance Policies

Our cell phone and attendance policies have been updated. As you look through the handbook please take some extra time to review these policies with your children. These changes have been added as a result of the laws that have been passed in our recent legislative sessions. Feel free to contact me if you have specific questions .

Arrival and Dismissal Procedures

Our procedures have been created with the intent to keep our students safe during their arrival and dismissal. It is a very high traffic time. So, please read the following procedures carefully.

ARRIVAL:

Buses and parents transporting children to school and arriving before 8:00 am will drop off students at the gym entrance. We will have supervision at the entrance beginning at 7:35. If parents are behind a bus, please wait for the bus to move forward before allowing your child to exit your vehicle. Students need to exit from the passenger side.

Students will need to line up outside the gym door prior to entering the building. They will be allowed into the building at 7:45 am. All students will enter through the gym doors prior to 8:00 am

At 7:45, PreK through 6th grade students will be escorted to breakfast or to the gym. Students not eating breakfast will be able to walk around the gym or read a book until being excused to their classrooms at 8:00 am.

Arrival Schedule is as follows:

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| 7:35 | Colesburg Buses Arrive (leave by 7:45) |
| 7:50 | Walkers eating breakfast |
| 8:00 | Parent Drop Off and Walkers |
| 8:00 | Edgewood Buses |

Students that arrive at school after 8:00 will want to enter through the gym door if they are going to eat breakfast. They may enter through the main entrance if they are going straight to their classroom. For your child's safety, please do not drop off your child prior to 7:35, because we do not have staff to monitor students until that time. A quick reminder, any student entering the building after 8:15 will be tardy.

DISMISSAL:

1. All students will be escorted from the building to buses, parent's vehicles or excused to walk home. We will not have parents gathering in the cafeteria at the end of the day.
2. The office needs to know by **2:30pm** if you are changing your child's end of the day plan. This ensures we get your student to the appropriate place and home safely.
3. Edgewood Buses will line up at 3:15 and leave by 3:20
4. Once the buses leave, students being picked up by parents will exit through the Gym entrance about 3:20. Once the buses have left the driveway, parents can drive up to the building. There will be an adult to escort your child to the car.
5. Walkers will be dismissed through the main entrance at 3:30.
6. Colesburg buses will leave around 3:40.

Student Handbook

The handbook has been updated and is located on the webpage. Please take some time to review the information. I would like to highlight a couple of items found in the handbook. When your child is going to be absent please call the office and let Chelsea know. She will let the teacher know and we can record it in our attendance system. Teachers are really busy and may not get the message to the office. We want to avoid bothering you with a phone call about your child's absence.

In addition, contact the office if your child will be late or if you are changing their dismissal plans. Once again, teachers are busy throughout the day and may not read the text or email until it is too late. Contacting the office will allow us to make sure your child gets home safely.

If your child brings a phone to school they will be expected to keep it put away during the day from 7:45 am to 3:40 pm. They will not be allowed to use it during recess or class time. This includes after school recess and while waiting in the parent pick up line or cafeteria. If you need to get a message to your child, please contact the office. We will relay the message or make sure you are able to communicate with your son/daughter. Please review all of the expectations in the handbook.

Visiting the Building:

Visitors are always welcome in the building. The following procedures will ensure the safety of all of our students. The doors will be locked at all times. So when you come to the building, you will need to press the button that is to the right of the front door. There is a speaker so you can speak with us and we can speak with you. The door will be opened for you. Once you enter the building, report to the office and sign in and you will be given a visitor sticker. There is more information about visiting the school in the handbook. You are expected to sign out of the office at the end of your visit. Feel free to contact the office with any questions.
